Call Forwarding Remotely and Abbreviated Dial (AbbrDial)


You may forward incoming calls to your voice mail or another number via the internet (for example, you could do this from home) and you can set up frequently dialed numbers with the **AbbrDial** (speed dial) feature.


- 1. Go to http://cu-cm-1/ccmuser.

5. To configure call forwarding options, select **Line Settings**.





9. To set up speed dial numbers, select **Speed Dials**.









10. You will then see the following screen:



- 11. Enter a *phone number*. Type a 9, the area code, and then the rest of the phone number. Do not include dashes or spaces.
- 12. Press **Tab**. Enter a *label* for each number.
- 13. Press **Tab** two times to go to the next line. Enter another number and label.
- 14. When finished entering numbers, click the **Save** button and then the **Apply Config** button.



15. An "apply configuration" window will appear. Click the **OK** button.



16. Logout when you are finished.

Using Abbreviated Dialing

- 1. Leave the handset in the cradle.
- 2. Dial the **Speed Dial number**.
- 3. Select **AbbrDial** from the list of Soft Keys on the screen. The phone will insert the respective speed dial number and call the recipient.
