Microsoft Office 365 news

Microsoft has announced new options for availability of some of the components from Office Pro Plus for Higher Education. University employees and students who have an Office 365 account can download up to 5 copies.



DoIT is currently testing compatibility of Office Pro Plus on Creighton owned Apple and Windows computers. Until the testing is completed, we are recommending that employees NOT download Office Pro Plus to CU owned Apple and Windows computers. However, employees can download to their personal or CU owned iOS device and Android phones.




