We all know using unique, strong passwords is critical in protecting both our systems and identities. Unfortunately, this results in each of us having dozens and dozens of different usernames and passwords for our various accounts and services. While it may be tempting to store these passwords on a sticky note under your keyboard, the easiest and most secure storage method would be with a password manager. These password managers work by securely storing your passwords in an encrypted file sometimes referred to as a password vault. The only way for these passwords to be decrypted and displayed is for you to type the master password.

Here within DoIT, we offer an on premise service called Passwordstate. Passwordstate is a secure, web based password manager that allows for both individuals and teams to store, access, and share passwords. You can store passwords that are visible only to yourself, or you can choose to share your passwords with coworkers. It is integrated with Active Directory, so the only password you need to remember is your BLUE password. It is an easy and convenient way to document, store, and share all of your DoIT passwords.
